## Average Annual Number of Wet Days and Rainfall

With abundant sunshine during all seasons, Sydney encourages outdoor recreational pursuits such as golf, sailing, going to the beach and bushwalking. Sydney has sunshine on an average 342 days per year and the range of its average temperatures between the hottest and coldest months is less than 11 degrees Celsius. Snow falls in the higher altitudes of New South Wales' southern tablelands, where a number of ski resorts operate during winter.
