## Work with IINSW

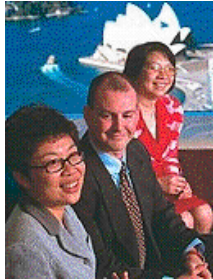


The State & Regional Development and Tourism division (SRDT) of Industry & Investment NSW (IINSW) is the NSW Government's key business development agency.
